SYNOPSIS

THE PUPPET MAN is a short slasher film featuring supermodel Crystal Renn in her acting debut and music by and a cameo from John Carpenter. Based on a childhood character created by artist and lead actor Johnny Scuotto, THE PUPPET MAN follows a group of friends who are locked inside an abandoned dive bar and seduced by a killer and his alter ego.



DIRECTOR'S STATEMENT

I've always been drawn to horror films as a means to explore the confrontation between reality and the unknown. Read on a deeper, metaphorical level, this dynamic examines society's simultaneous attraction and rejection of the inexplicable, its struggle to come to terms with that which cannot be explained or accounted for.

Shot in NYC and LA with a mix of artists and close friends on a micro budget, THE PUPPET MAN was inspired by lead actor Johnny Scuotto's childhood infatuation with a puppet his father taunted him with when he misbehaved. I met Johnny through the NYC music scene as he was developing an alter ego based on this character – with his shaved eyebrows, wide brimmed black hat, and jumpsuit with the words "Puppet Man" scrawled on the back, I was instantly intrigued and impressed by his authentic, magnetic, and utterly confrontational personality.

So when my exec producer Caleb Braaten proposed the idea of working with John Carpenter on a film project, I called up the Puppet Man and asked him out for coffee. Through a series of midnight hang outs, cryptic phone calls and exquisite corpse inspired email chains, we developed the character for the screen.



"I'M JUST FUCKING WITH YOU."

We ran the script by John, who agreed to a cameo, and three days later Caleb and I were flying to Los Angeles on Halloween to shoot his scene in the same model station wagon driven by his iconic character Michael Myers. With no time or money for permits, I asked John to meet us on an abandoned street corner in a shady part of the valley. He arrived, chain-smoking, and grilled me, testing me as a director while slipping in obscure ASSAULT ON PRECINCT 13 references. I kept my cool, but my anxiety must have registered because he finally paused, broke into a smile, and remarked, "I'm just fucking with you."

As our cast and crew began to assemble for principal photography in NYC, Crystal Renn was brought to my attention via my producer Greg Eggebeen. While I was initially skeptical of casting a model in the lead role, I was quickly stunned by her fearlessness, dedication, and complete vulnerability on set. I found my dream girl in Crystal, not only as a newly minted actress who could scream on command in sub zero-temperatures, but as a black-clad kindred spirit who was quickly reading the entire cast and crews astrological charts on set.

The stories from this project are endless, from being loaned a shirt by Johnny that had allegedly belonged to Charles Manson for Bradley Bailey's character of the Bartender, to sound designing the film at David Lynch's home studio amidst transcendental meditation sessions. THE PUPPET MAN was a wild and profound experience, one I'll never forget, and one which aligns with my goals as a director to bring the stories from the fringes to a larger audience, brought forth by an army of close alliances and friendships with people that I trust and truly believe in.
